Almost every department organized seminar/ webinars of which students were the main part. Talks were focused on student needs and present scenario of COVID-19. EMPLOYABILITY – Syllabus is designed in such a way as to provide recent information to the students which helps them in getting employment. Due to pandemic campus placements were not possible.
